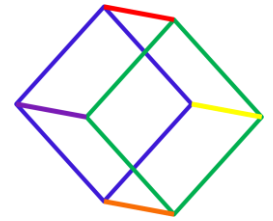


## LEARNING OUTSIDE THE BOX Geography Scavenger Hunt

H:	What is the major industry of <b>Houston</b> ?	energy, primarily related to oil
I:	Which <b>island</b> is the largest in the Caribbean?	Cuba
J:	What is the tallest mountain in <b>Japan</b> ?	Mount Fuji
K:	Which national park is in <b>Kentucky</b> ?	Mammoth Cave National Park
L:	In which nation are <b>lochs</b> common?	Scotland (Scotland is a nation within the United Kingdom)
M:	Find any state that borders <b>Maryland</b> .	any of Virginia, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, Delaware
N:	<b>Nanjing</b> is a megacity in which country?	China
O:	In which city does the <b>Ohio River</b> start?	Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania
P:	Which U.S. state surrounds <b>Puget Sound</b> ?	Washington
Q:	What is the dominant language spoken in <b>Qatar</b> ?	Arabic
R:	Which <b>river</b> forms the border between Iowa and Nebraska?	Missouri River
S:	Which is the most populous city in <b>Silicon Valley</b> ?	San Jose, California
